Relocating Indigeneity

- Canada: 69% of all Aboriginal people live in cities; 81% of Registered Indians live in cities; 69% of Non-Registered Indians; 65% of Metis, 22% of Inuit
- USA: The census for 1990 reported that 63 percent of Indian people lived in cities
